Seaside	A place by the sea
Bathing machine	A wheeled hut drawn to the edge of the sea, used for changing in
Esplanade	A long path typically beside the sea which people may walk along
King George III	King George the 3 rd was the king between 1760-1820
Tourist	A person/people who are visiting a place for pleasure
Beach hut	A structure on or next to a beach used for privacy or shelter while visiting the beach
Holiday resort	A place that is visited for holidays
White horse	A figure made of white stones in the shape of a horse on a hill
Jubilee Clock	A free-standing clock tower on the Esplanade in Weymouth . Built in 1888 to celebrate the Golden jubilee of Queen Victoria
