<p>Global Citizenship:</p> <p>Tourism is one of the biggest industries in the world but do the positives outweigh the negatives with the impact of littering, footpath erosion etc. Are tourist attractions a positive or a negative on the environment?</p>	<p>MATHS:</p> <p>Recap of previous Year 5 learning – four operations, prime, square etc. Children will be learning about the properties of shape and measurement. Identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces.
